When you join the AIA, you become a member at the National, State and Local levels; obtain the benefits of and pay dues to all three entities.

Note: The Inland California Chapter charges no Supplemental Dues.

National, State and Local Chapter Dues:

Dues for National, California and the Inland California Chapter are shown below for a first-time member. Local and State dues are graduated over a three-year period.

Local: The first year is \$60 the second \$120 and the third and thereafter, \$180.

State: The first year is \$99 the second \$198 and the third and thereafter, \$262.

National dues are \$244.
