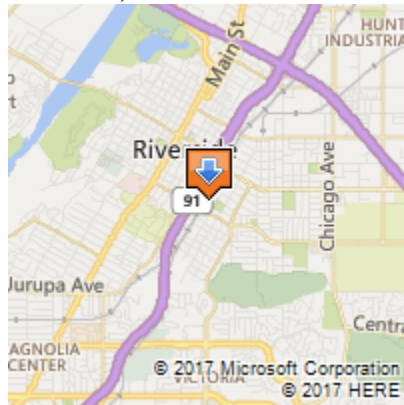

In 2008, the complex was further studied and determined eligible for listing on the National Register of Historic Places. The complex's historical significance at both the local and national levels is tied to its relationship to the Water Buffalo military landing craft.
